


## CEDARVILLE MILLAGE – 36.0

The total rate of proposed above includes the uniform rate of 25.0 mills (the “Statewide Uniform Rate”) to be collected on all taxable property in the State and remitted to the State Treasurer pursuant to Amendment No. 74 to the Arkansas Constitution to be sued solely for the maintenance and operation of the schools in the State.

As provided in Amendment No. 74, the Statewide Uniform Rate replaces a portion of the existing rate of tax levied by this School District. The total proposed school tax levy of 36.0 mills includes 25.0 mills for maintenance and operation and 11.0 mills specifically voted as a continuing levy pledge for the retirement of existing bonded indebtedness. The surplus revenues produced by the District for other school purposes. The total proposed school tax levy of 36.0 mills represents the same rate presently being collected.
