RE: ***Designation of Poll Worker Trainers***

It is time for the county election commission to designate two (2) people to be trained, tested, and certified by the State Board of Election Commissioners to train poll workers on Election Day administrative procedures in your county before the primary election.

Designees who successfully complete the training and pass a test will be certified by the State Board as trainers and will then train the county's poll workers using materials provided by the State Board. This system provides each county with the flexibility to train its poll workers when needed.

All materials supplied by the State Board are required to be used to train the local election officials. If your county wishes to use materials other than the materials provided to you from the State Board, you must submit those materials to the Board and receive written approval to use alternative materials before you begin county training. The State Board encourages counties to include additional material to fit the specific county needs. However, it is unlawful to substitute training materials which have not been approved by the State Board. *SBEC Rule §203*

A maximum of two (2) certified trainers per county are eligible for \$100 compensation for attending training, plus an additional \$50 each per poll worker training session (maximum of 4) conducted locally before the primary. If you believe your county needs more than two certified trainers, you may apply to the SBEC for a waiver which would allow additional trainers to receive reimbursement. The certified trainers' compensation will be paid by the State Board to the County Treasurer upon receipt of the reporting form approved and provided by the State Board to the county for that purpose.

Please indicate on the designee form (see next page) the names, addresses and other contact information for two people, preferably individuals who already have some election experience and are comfortable speaking to large groups, who will attend training to be certified by the State Board to train poll workers in your county before the primary. Please note that the material covered in this training focuses on Election Day administrative procedures and does not cover voting equipment. Our office will follow-up with the designees with more information about the training sessions.

If there are more than two people from your county that you would like to attend this training, we will make every effort to accommodate your request to certify as many as possible. However, the State Board can financially only reimburse the county for two official designees.

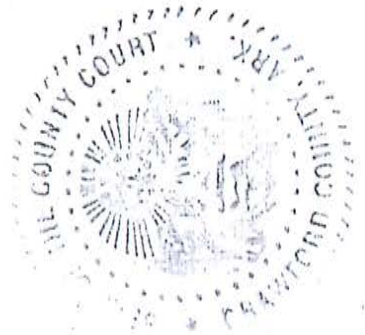

Directors,

Annually, the County Board of Election Commissioners is required to consult with each school district prior to the Annual School Election [A.C.A. § 6-14-106 (a)(2)]. The purpose of this letter is to present the options available to the Alma School Board for the upcoming Annual School Election to be held on November 14th, 2023. The list of candidates certified by the Crawford County Clerk includes only one candidate from the Alma School District thus the Alma School Board has three options [A.C.A. § 6-14-102 (c)(1)]:

1. Do nothing. This option will mean the election will be carried out in the traditional fashion; absentee ballots will be sent out to those who properly request them, a polling place will be established for early voting, and one or more polling places will be established for election day voting.
2. The Alma School Board may pass a resolution requesting that the election be conducted by absentee ballot and early voting only. This would mean that no polling places will be open on election day.
3. The Alma School Board may pass a resolution requesting the Crawford County Board of Election Commissioners declare an election by candidate. This would mean that no polling places would be opened for early vote or on election day. Instead, the lone candidate would cast a single ballot.

The Election Commissioners recommend the third option as it is the least expensive. The referenced sections of the Arkansas Code as well as a pair of example resolutions are attached. A member of the Election Commission will be available at the next Alma School Board meeting on September 14th to answer questions regarding this election.
