#### **Election Coordinator Job Description:**

- Manages the day-to-day operations of the CBEC
  - Answer phones
  - Respond to FOIA requests
  - o Pay bills
- Program, prepare, and test voting machines and equipment
  - o Attend all training required to maintain PYO status
- Coordinate and train poll workers
  - o Process poll worker applications
  - o Verify poll worker eligibility, availability, and willingness to serve
- Maintain relationships with the owners of polling sites, recommend new polling sites to the CBEC
- Determine best distribution of equipment and poll workers to polling sites
- Set up and disassemble poll sites
  - o Requires a valid driver's license and the operation of a large truck
- Prepare election documents including ballot forms, public notices, required postings, forms, etc.
- Advise CBEC and attend all CBEC meetings
  - Provide coordinator's report to include budget changes month to month, FOIA responses, election law or rule changes, etc.
- Bill for reimbursement all qualified election expenses
- Study election laws, rules, and best practices and develop plans to implement them into CBEC standard practices
- Maintain the CBEC website in partnership with the website developer
- Maintain public relations of the CBEC. Interact with the media and other interested parties regarding elections
